**Format:** Matches are best of 5 games to 11 points. RR groups of 4-5. The USATT-rated player with best record in each RR group will advance to crossover play in the form of a Single Elimination Tournament. Unrated players will not advance to crossover play and are not eligible for prize money/trophies with the exception of Open Singles. Scores will be 11-7, 11-7, and 11-7 on all defaults.

**Tournament Eligibility & Rules:** The tournament is open to all USATT members. All USATT rules and regulations apply including USATT dress code (**no white clothing!**). The tournament management may modify the format and prize money with a reduced number of entries. Events with insufficient entries may be cancelled and fees refunded. Eligibility will be based on ratings.

**Ratings and Registration:** Ratings for entry, listed as of February 17, 2017. Ratings for seeding based on March 3, 2017.
