Eligibility: Open to all members of the USATT. Non-members may join by paying the membership fee with their entry. Details on entry form. Players who have never been USATT members may buy a one time only Tournament Pass.

Event Eligibility: **Rating events**: players are eligible if their rating is below the rating listed for the event or they are unrated. Unrated players can not advance from round robin groups in rating limited events for events above 750. **Age events**: Players must be over the age bracket as of 8/6/2023. **Double events**: The highest player rating in each doubles team cannot be greater than 200 points compared to their partner.

Registration: Register by visiting https://www.omnipong.com/T-tourney.asp?t=108&r=3189, creating a member account, enter our tournament, enter desired events, and pay in full by Venmo(@johnnyt2050 enter username into venmo or scan barcode below) with description of events entered. We DO NOT accept payment through Omnipong, you will not be prompted to enter any credit card information or charged in Omnipong if you try to pay through them. Alternatively, you may fill out the entry form on page 3 of this document with a check payable to Alameda Ping Pong Gym, mailed to 2050 Lincoln Avenue, Alameda, CA 94501. Each player must sign the waiver on page 4 of this document to compete, parent or guardian must sign for any player under 18 years old. Events and refunds: Events and times are subject to change, combination, or cancellation if there are not enough players. Players will be reimbursed if canceled. All events have limited entries, register before spots are filled. Entry limit of 4 total singles events per player, limit of 1 entry per start time.

Tournament rules/format: The Laws of Table Tennis as published by the ITTF and all USATT regulations apply. Games best of 5, first to 11 points. All events start with round robin groups of 3 or more, then advance to single elimination. Top seeded players may be seeded straight to single elimination in certain events. USATT Dress Code applies.

Start Times: Players must report to the control desk no later than 20 minutes prior to event start time. Failure to do so may result in cancellation from their events without refunds.

Practice: The facility will be open for warm-up 1 hour before event start time. The facility will not be open for general practice during tournament hours. However if there are any open tables, players are welcome to play, first come first serve.

Lessons: We have weekly group training and private lessons for all ages and levels hosted by our friendly coach Johnny T. He has over 30 recurring clients of all levels and personally competes around a 2000 USATT rating level. PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) **who have** regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.** To learn more about the appropriate agency where you can submit a report of child abuse, log onto: https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting.
