Deadline: Sunday, October 1, 2023. Unpaid entries on Omnipong will be removed after October 1, 2023 without any reminder or notifications from the Tournament Director. There will be no refund after the deadline, no exceptions.

Check-In: Starts at 8:00AM on October 7, 2023. Participants must check in 15 minutes prior to their first event.

Tournament Equipment: Nittaku Premium 3-star Poly 40+ sponsored by Paddle Palace white balls and Joola 3000SC PRO tables on maple wood floor

Tournament Format: All events are round robin followed by single elimination. All matches are best 3 out of 5. Players rated over 2400 will be seeded out of the Open Singles round robin and play their single elimination matches 2 hours later (at 12pm).

Membership: Proof of USATT membership is required. Membership may be purchased along with tournament entry. Adult basic membership \$25/year and Pro membership \$75/year.

Rating: The latest ratings from USATT database will be used for this tournament. Seedings are based on the most current ratings. Tournament Director reserves the rights to assign rating to unrated players for seeding purposes.

Aged/Women's/Men's Events Eligibility: Participant must be a Virginia resident by Entry Deadline in order to compete in the 2023 USATT Virginia State Championships. Forms of proof of residency, including Driver's License, Student ID, Recent Credit Card/Utilities Bill are acceptable. If a participant qualifies as a resident of more than one state, the participant must select one state in which he or she will compete. The participant may not compete in multiple state championships tournaments.

Rating Event Eligibility (Open Singles, U2200, U2000, and U1800): Participants can be residents of any state. Unrated players are NOT allowed to advance into single elimination round. For unrated players to advance, players must come 30 minutes before the start of the event to be evaluated by a professional club coach and assigned an estimated rating to enter the appropriate event(s).

Policies: The 2023 USATT Virginia State Championships will be conducted under the USATT Rules. If there are insufficient entries, events can be cancelled, combined, or reformatted at the discretion of the Tournament Director. In case of event cancellation, the Tournament Director No prizes will be awarded for splits, dumps, default losses or no-shows. All decisions by the Tournament Director and/or the Referee will be final.

Liability: By entering this tournament, I/we hereby release the USATT, City of Newport News, NNTTC, sponsors, directors, and any individual or corporate body directly or remotely connected with this tournament from any and all actions, claims, and demands resulting from loss, damage, or injuries sustained to persons or property. We will abide by USATT regulations and NNTTC policies.

USATT SafeSport Protocol

_____ I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.
