- Each club fields **teams (3 players each)**

- **Divisions:**
 - Juniors (U18)
 - Ladies
 - ≤1300 USATT
 - ≤1700
 - ≤2000 / Club
 - Open
- **9 matches per division** (45 total)
- **1 point per match win**
- **Golden Game**
- **5 bonus points**
- 5 players (one per division) per club
- Race to **31 points**, win by one
- Tiebreaker if score is **25–25**
- **Logistics**
 - \$30 per active player (host club retains)
 - Traveling trophy funded by PPC (upfront)
 - Post-event celebration in downtown Tigard
 - P&PC to host next event
 - Potential future expansion to NW clubs
