# 2026 US OPEN TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIPS

**Membership:** USATT Pro Membership is required for participation in 2026 US Open Teams Championships

## Format:

- Each team match, except the SE Playoffs of Division 1, will consist of 3 players from each team (chosen from the full complement of 3-5), playing in a Swaythling Cup, best of 9 format. Individual matches will be 3 out of 5 games and must be played in order. Once a team has reached 5 matches won, no further matches will be played (and matches in progress will be abandoned). One team will be ABC, and the other will be XYZ. A coin flip determines which team captain gets the first choice between ABC and XYZ.
- For Division 1, teams will play the above 9-match Swaythling Cup format for divisional matches, and the Swaythling Cup 5-match format for the SE Playoffs. The 9-match format is A v X, B v Y, C v Z, B v X, A v Z, C v Y, B v Z, C v X, A v Y. 5-match format is A v X, B v Y, C v Z, A v Y, B v X.
- Each Team will play between 7 and 10 team ties and they will compete **in all 3 days of tournament.**

## Venue Food Policy

**No outside food, drink, or coolers allowed to be brought into the convention center. There will be food, water, and concessions available inside the venue.**



# 2026 US OPEN TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIPS

## USATT TOURNAMENT COACHING POLICY

An adult (a person over the age of 18) must be fully Safe Sport Compliant to coach and/or provide tournament in-match playing advice from the coach's corner to a Minor Athlete (person under the age of 18).

A parent and/or legal guardian is permitted to coach his or her own child without being Safe Sport Compliant.

An adult is permitted to coach and/or provide tournament in-match playing advice from the coach's corner to another Adult Participant without being Safe Sport Compliant.

A minor is permitted to coach and/or provide tournament in-match playing advice from the coach's corner to another Minor Athlete without being Safe Sport Compliant. A minor is NOT PERMITTED to coach an Adult Participant (who is not the minor's parent or legal guardian), unless the Adult Participant has completed training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

### USATT SAFE SPORT POLICY AWARENESS AND COMPLIANCE

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

I understand, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention (MAAP) Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have regular contact with or authority over minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

For the purposes of USATT's MAAP Policy, "regular contact with" is defined as: "ongoing interactions during a 12-month period wherein an Adult Participant is in a role of direct and active engagement with any Minor Athlete(s)"; and "authority over" is defined as: "when one person's position over another person is such that, based on the totality of the circumstances, they have the power or right to direct, control, give orders to, or make decisions for that person."



# 2026 US OPEN TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIPS

**Rules:** The 2026 US Open Teams Table Tennis Championship matches will be conducted under the ITTF Laws of Table Tennis. Rules of match play are determined by the Referee. All matters, issues, guidelines, and ancillary decisions beyond match play related to sponsors and tournament venue decoration will be determined by the Tournament Director in accordance with USATT Policies and Procedures, including the USATT Member Code of Conduct.

**Match Scoring:** All Matches will utilize 11-point Best-of-Five Game Rules.

**Clothing:** The USATT Dress Code will be enforced. No white clothing will be allowed. Players must wear their respective assigned player number or have their name printed on the back of their shirt when competing. Names must be large and visible to spectators. It is recommended that each player come to the table with two distinctively different colored shirts, as referees will sometimes require opponents to have different colored shirts in important matches with spectators.

**Mandatory Match Check-In:** All Teams must check in at least 30 minutes before their scheduled Match. Failure to report to Control Desk at least 15 minutes before will result in Team losing the right to assign the roster, a Default Roster will be assigned by Control Desk.

**Cancellation Without Fault:** USATT will refund 50% of all entry fees paid by participants if the U.S. Open event is cancelled or partially cancelled due to acts of God, force majeure, war within the continental U.S., governmental authority, disaster strikes, civil disorder, or curtailment of transportation services that prevent at least 50% or more of USATT participation from attending the event.

**Prize Money Checks:** Prize money will not be paid for no-shows, splits, dumping, or defaults (except for verified cases of injury, illness, or emergency). Prize money checks which are not claimed at the tournament site will be mailed to the winner within one month of the conclusion of the tournament. Prize money checks that are not cashed within 120 days will be forfeited.
