 - 7. Eligibility** Only athletes eligible, according to the rules and regulations of the ITTF, to represent their country in the Pan Am Games Team Trials, & 1st National Ranking Tournament. Only USATT members in good standing of USATT may participate.  - 8. Prizes** Prizes will be given as a value in kind for future ITTF Tournaments or TTTTeam USA travel. 1st place \$1,500 2nd place \$1,000 3rd place \$750
 - 9. Qualified Players** The top eight (8) players of each gender will automatically advance to the main draw. The remaining eight (8) spots will be allocated based on February 2019 ITTF WR for any player in the top 300. If fewer than eight (8) players are in the top 300, the remaining spots will be allocated based on USATT Ranking. All others participate in the qualification event.
 - 10. Qualifier** The winner of each gender will qualify to the 2019 Pan Am Games Team. For the 2019 Selection Procedures please visit <https://www.teamusa.org/USA-Table-Tennis/Team-USA/2019-Pan-Am-Games-Team-Selection-Procedures>
 - 10. Entry Fee** \$250 USD per player
 - 11. Format of play** The qualification will be played as Single elimination best of 7 games and eight (8) players of each gender will play in the main draw best of 7 games. Sixteen (16) players of each gender will play in the main draw best of 7 games. For stage 1 players will be divided into two groups of eight (8) RR. For stage 2 the top four (4) players from each group will be combined into a group of eight (8) RR; and the bottom four (4) players from each group will be combined into a second group of eight (8) RR. The final top three (3) places will only be in the Championship group. For stage 2 the matches against the opponents from stage 1 will be played.
- Players not advancing from the qualification may enter the Golden Western Tournament.

premature departure will no longer be accepted.
- 21. Racket Controls:** If racket control includes official test for VOC, miniRAE devices will be used according to
ITTF decision. In this case, players will be invited to voluntarily tests their rackets before
competition starts.
