Events Players may only enter their assigned age category, which will be determined b based on ITTF age criteria.				
	Men's and Women's Doubles by age group Players may only enter into one doubles event, however are not required to enter their age category. Instead, players may play in a different age group based on the age group of their partner, however the age category will be determined based on the youngest player in the pairing. For example, a 67 year old may play in the 50-59 if their partner is in the 50-59 age group.			
	Players are encouraged, but not required, to play doubles. If a player does not have a doubles partner, the organizers will assign a doubles partner in that age category prior to the event. The organizers will make every effort to assign partners from the same country.			
	There is no additional entry fee required to participate in the doubles event.

Playing System	Qualification Stage All players are required to play in the qualification stage, which will take place during the first day of the competition. Players (and for doubles) will play in round robin groups of three or four. Please note the qualifications stage may also be played on the second day of the competition for certain age groups (based on number of entries).			
	Single Knock – Out Doubles Main Draw and Consolation Draw All double will advance to the single knock-out stage based on the order of finish in the qualification stage. The first two doubles in each group will advance to the Main Draw, and the remainder of the doubles in each group will advance to the Consolation Draw.			
	Progressive Knock – Out Singles Main Draw and Consolation Draw All players will advance to the progressive knock-out stage based on the order of finish in the qualification stage. The first two players in each group will advance to the Main Draw, and the

All matches will be played best-of-five games.

- Default Players who do not complete the Qualification Stage of the round robin play (singles or doubles) for whatever reason will be considered as "defaulted" and will not be eligible to compete in the Main Draw. Defaulted players will only be eligible to compete in the Consolation Draw with the permission of the Competition Manager or Tournament Director.
- **Draw** The Draw for the Qualification Stage will be posted no less than 48 hours prior to the start of the event, however the Competition Manager reserves the right to change, edit, or otherwise amend the draw up to 24 hours prior to the start of the event.

Players are strongly encouraged to check their draw, which will be posted at the event site, on the morning of the event.

It is the registrants' responsibility to confirm registration prior to arrival at the event. Cancellation In principal, a player may cancel at any time prior to the start of the event. However, the following tournament entry refund policy shall apply: If more than 60 days prior to the start date or within three (3) days of entry, player shall be refunded 100% of the entry fee less a 5% administrative fee. If between 30 and 59 days prior to the starting date for the event, player shall be . refunded 50% of the entry fee less a 5% administrative fee. If less than 30 days prior to the starting date for the event, player shall not be entitled . to a refund. Wire transfer processing fees are non-refundable. **Force Majeure** Should the Event be cancelled due to weather or other circumstances beyond the control of the Organizer or in the case of a Force Majeure resulting in the Event being cancelled, no refund will be made. The Organizer shall have no other responsibilities and/or liabilities. Force Majeure includes and is not limited to the Organizer being unable to perform its obligations or organize or hold the Event due to fire, flood, earthquake, or other severe natural disaster or act of God; or due to protest, riot, civil disobedience, uprising, march, revolt, assembly, demonstration, occupation, commotion, mass gathering, war, insurrection, sabotage, epidemic, or terrorist attack or the likelihood of such event or act. Important Players are encouraged to have their name and country on the back of their shirts. Information It is mandatory for all participants to wear their player number (inclusive of the advertising printed thereon) made available by the organizers. Number and advertising must be clearly visible. Injury/Illness To compete, participating players are responsible for their physical and mental fitness. It is recommended that a routine check-up ahead of the event should be carried out by a doctor. The Organizing Committee does not provide health insurance for participants. Any costs for medication, bandages or other medical services will not be born by the Organizing Committee.
