Event Information

1. Events 1-19; 21-25; & 27-29, all players must be current USATT members or purchase a tournament pass. (See membership information on entry portion). Memberships can be purchased at the tournament.
2. Event 30 (Handicap) players must have a current USATT rating (within 3 years).
3. Event 26 (Recreational), entry is for players who have never been rated and on-site registration is permitted.
4. Events 27, 28 and 29 are Giant RR events. Players will be seeded in RR groups of at least 6 with top 4 in each group advancing to single elimination. Be prepared to play 6 to 10 matches.
5. Event 30 (41 Point Handicap) is unrated, single elimination and open only to rated players. Players rated 2300 and over have free entry in this event.
6. All matches will be 3 of 5 games, except for Open Singles, which is 4 of 7 in the quarters, semis, and finals. Event 30 (Handicap) is one game to 41 points.
7. Format will be RR groups of 4 with top player advancing in all events, except Giant RR events (27, 28 and 29). Handicap is single elimination.
8. Unrated players may enter any event (except Handicap) **BUT** will not advance from their round robin in events 2 through 19, and 27, 28 and 29.
9. Depending on entries, top seeded players in Open singles may be placed directly into the elimination round.
10. Age cutoff for events 21 and 22 is 9/25/20; for events 23 and 24 is 12/31/20.
11. Any event starting 6:00 PM or later on Saturday **MAY** carryover elimination rounds to Sunday.
12. Players may not enter more than one event with the same starting time. **Default time is start time.**
13. Tournament management may modify, combine, or cancel events, limit total entries or total entries by event.

14. All players pay \$10 registration fee.
15. All USATT rules will be enforced including approved tie-breaking rules. Boosters or glue with VOC's are not permitted. No prizes awarded for splits, dumps, defaults, or no-shows. No white shirts, shorts or skirts.
16. Ratings as of 8/1/20 will be used for event eligibility; seeding will be based upon latest USATT available ratings. For Open Singles and Open Doubles, players **MAY** be seeded according to their ITTF WR.
17. No refunds after published entry deadline of September 18, 2020.
