Attention, PLEASE READ: This is modified Giant Round Robin event. **Maximum entries are 40**. We will start with eight preliminary, 5-player round robins. (4 matches each) Based on your results, everyone will be placed into one of the five, 8-man divisions. These divisions are Championship (1st place finishers of pre-RR), Gold (2nd place finishers), Silver (3rd place finishers), Bronze (4th place finishers) and Steel (5th place finishers). Each 8-person division will then be split into two 4-player RR. (10 total) (3 matches each) Top two finishers of 4-player RR will advance to single elimination, semi's and final within each division. Assuming all 40 entries show up, (which I will endeavor to accomplish) you will play 7 matches in the 2 RR sessions. 4 players from each division (20 total) who advance, will play one semifinal (10 matches). Winners advance to division finals. (5 matches). 10 players will play 9 matches. This format is probably a bit different than your used to, however it is a competitive way to play many matches. Unrated players can advance out of RR and int the single elimination.



PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT.

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be Fully Safe Sport Compliant, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT.

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.
