ELIGIBILITY: Open to all members of the USATT. Non-members may join the USATT by including the membership fee with their entry fee. Players who are not current USATT members may buy a basic USATT Membership pass for \$25. Unrated players may enter any event but may not be allowed to advance from the round robin except in the Championship event.

DEADLINE: Saturday September 2nd, 2023. Entry fees must accompany entry form (unpaid entries removed 7 days after reminder email). \$5 charge for any entries received or paid for after September 2nd, 2023. No entries allowed after Tuesday September 5th, 2023. No refunds after entry deadline September2, 2023.

Format: All events will start with round robin groups. In the Championship event, 2 players from each group will advance to single elimination playoffs. In all other events, group winners will advance to single elimination playoffs. Unrated players cannot advance from the round robin except in the Championship event.

Ratings: Unrated players should submit an estimated rating and the source of the rating upon entering an event.

Matches: All games will be to 11 points; Championship event matches will be best of 7 for semi-finals and finals; all other matches are best of 5 games.

RULES: The Laws of Table Tennis as published by the ITTF and all USATT regulations will be enforced.

EQUIPMENT: Only USATT approved equipment will be used: 16 Donic tables and nets; white Nittaku $\star \star \star$ Premium 40+ (plastic) balls; Wooden floor. NOTE: RACKETS: one side of the racket must be an ITTF approved racket covering that is not black, the other side must be black.

CLOTHING: The USATT Dress Code applies. The main color of the body of the shirt or shorts may not be white. Please dress in appropriate athletic attire. Designs or lettering that are distracting to an opponent or are offensive will not be permitted. Socks and rubber-soled, non-marking, shoes must be worn.

REPORTING AND STARTING TIMES: Players must register at the desk at least 15 minutes before their events. Players not on time may be defaulted for the entire event (and replaced by an alternate) at the discretion of the referee.

AWARDS: See event chart above for cash prizes. Trophies for winners and runners-up in all events.

PRACTICE: The gym will be open for practice at 8:00 a.m. Saturday.

UMPIRES: Umpires will be provided on request if available.

CANCELLATION: The committee reserves the right to cancel the tournament or modify the format based on entries received. All entrants will be refunded if tournament must be cancelled.

Directions: Lucky Shoals Park – Off I-85, 4.8 miles North of I-285, turn South onto Jimmy Carter Blvd and drive 2.1 miles to Britt Road; Turn right on Britt Road 0.4 miles to Lucky Shoals Park on the Left. (Identified by a large aqua colored sign).

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.



I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have regular contact with or authority over minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <u>https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport</u>.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be Fully Safe Sport Compliant, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.** To learn more about the appropriate agency where you can submit a report of child abuse, log onto: https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting.
