### **ENTRY DEADLINE**

October 2, 2023

### **RATING RULES**

- Event eligibility will be determined by rating list generated on September 9, 2023
- The most recent rating will be used for seeding.

### **PLAYING FORMAT**

Event will start with a RR group of 3-4 players, followed by singles elimination playoff. All matches are best of 5 to 11 points, except the semi-final and final of the Men and Women's Singles which will be played best of 7 games. The Tournament Director reserves the right to directly seed players into the single elimination event bracket draw based on USATT Ratings

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The event is for CA residents only, including students studying in CA. US citizenship is not required. USATT membership is required and must be valid through the date of the tournament (\$25/yr or more). Details on USATT membership can be found on USATT website.

### **DEFAULTS**

The tournament referee has the authority to determine a default.

### **ENTRY FEES**

- \$48-\$68 per event, details find on event schedule.
- \$10 off per event for <u>early bird entries</u> paid by September 1
- \$15 registration fee
- \$15 late fee to enter after the entry deadline if space permits.

### **CANCELLATION**

- Entry fees will be fully refunded if an event is cancelled due to insufficient signups.
- A withdrawal request received by September 22
  is eligible for a refund. Email us at

   A processing fee of \$20 will be deducted from a

### **UNRATED PLAYER**

- Unrated players may not advance to SE in rating events excepting U900, U700, U500, U300, & U100.
- Estimated ratings from USATT certified coaches will not be accepted.

#### **MATCH CHECK IN**

Players need to check in at the control desk at least 30 minutes before their first match and be ready to play each match 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time. Players who are not present at match starting time for any event forfeit their position and entry fees.

#### **SPECTATOR PASS**

10/8 Sunday events require tickets to enter for all spectators (\$10 at the door). All players of the tournament will be allowed to watch. Junior players may bring one adult for free entry. Full-time coach please email info@ttamerica.org before September 30th to get a free pass.

### PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain Positions of Authority must complete Safe Sport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring Full Safe Sport Compliance is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <a href="https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport">https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport</a>.

#### **USATT COACHING POLICY**

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents /legal guardians coaching their own children, must be Fully Safe Sport Compliant, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing criminal background screen every two years.

### ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFE SPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

### CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at <a href="mailto:admin@usatt.org">admin@usatt.org</a> for more information and guidance in this process.

#### **MANDATORY REPORTING**

There are certain circumstances where reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.
