Entry Deadline: April 15, 2026. \$5 additional fee for all late payment after deadline.

Eligibility for Event: Open to all members of USA Table Tennis (USATT). Non-members/Inactive members may join/renew the USATT by including the membership fee (Gold membership \$100, Silver membership \$50) with their entry fee.

Rules: The Laws of Table Tennis as published by the ITTF and all USATT regulations will be enforced.

Rackets- One side of the racket must be bright red or another color recently approved by ITTF, the other side black. No complete regluing unless it is a new sheet of rubber. Partial re-gluing may be done with the permission

of and under supervision of the referee.

Clothing- The USATT Dress Code applies. The main color of the body of the shirt or shorts may not be white. Please dress in appropriate athletic attire. Designs or lettering that are distracting to an opponent or are offensive will not be permitted. Rubber-soled, non-marking, shoes must be worn.

Equipment: Butterfly Europa/Centrefold 25 tables/nets, & Butterfly 3-star 40+mm white plastic balls. Red rubber floor. ITTF/USATT approved equipment only.

Format: Play will be in two stages in each event, Round Robin and single elimination playoff. All events will start with round robin (3 to 5 players a group). Top 2 winners for Championship and U2400 will advance to single elimination playoffs. The top 1 player advances for U2100 to U1000. All matches are best of 5 games.

Players must check-in at the control desk 15 minutes before event start time. Players arriving late may be defaulted for the event. The court will open for participants' practices 4:00pm-9:00pm on Friday and 8:00am-8:55am on Saturday.

Cancellation: Director reserves the right to modify any event or cancel the event/tour. The total fee will be refunded if the event is cancelled by organizer. \$10 non-refundable administration fee for cancellations prior to deadline upon player's written request and the event entry fee and rating fee will be refunded. NO REFUNDS AFTER April 15, 2026. THANK YOU!

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport>.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**. 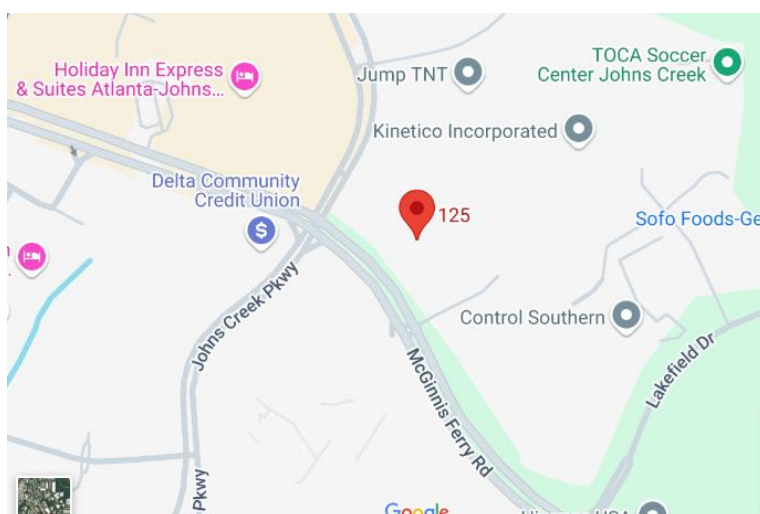
