## PROSPECTUS

<b>Venue</b>	Story Mill Community Center, 600 Bridger Canyon Dr., Bozeman, MT 59715
<b>Date</b>	Saturday, September 07, 2024
<b>Time</b>	09:00 until whenever. Doors open at 08:00.
<b>Tournament Committee</b>	Thor Truelson, Nathan Wilcox, Joel Kennet, Lex Moy, Lena Conlan, Anders Truelson
<b>Eligibility</b>	Open to all. This event is not sanctioned by the USATT.
<b>Rules</b>	The tournament shall be governed by ITTF rules. All matches are 3 out of 5 sets to 11 points.
<b>Equipment</b>	White Joola® Prime 40+ balls, hardwood gym flooring. White attire may not be worn for match play. Joola tables will be used.
<b>Format</b>	<p><b>Open Singles:</b> Preliminary pools of 3 or 4 players, with the first-place finisher advancing to Division 1, 2<sup>nd</sup> place to Division 2, 3<sup>rd</sup> place to Division 3 and 4<sup>th</sup> place to Division 4. Each of the subsequent divisions will be single elimination.</p> <p>Seedings will be made according to current ITTF ranking, USATT rating, CTTA rating, or alternative rating systems (e.g. Ratings Central) or other national classification system. The top 8 to 16 players will be seeded and all others will be placed randomly in the preliminary pool. The geographic separation of players will be observed to the greatest extent possible.</p> <p>The tournament committee reserves the right to amend the format as necessary, depending on the number of entries.</p>

	<b>Open Doubles:</b> The format will be preliminary groups with all teams advancing to either Division 1 (1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> place finishers) or Division 2 (3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> place finishers), where matches will be single elimination.
<b>Scorekeeping</b>	All matches will have scorekeepers. The loser of a match must remain at the table and keep score for the subsequent match. No exceptions. You will be given a couple minutes to compose yourself or use the WC, but then must return to keep score at that table. Failure to do so will result in being defaulted from any subsequent matches and a forfeiture of any winnings.
<b>Prizes</b>	Cash USD for first, second and semifinals of Division 1 of Open Singles. Merchandise prizes for 1 <sup>st</sup> through 4 <sup>th</sup> place finishers in each other divisions of Open Singles. Cash USD for first and second of Division 1 of Open Doubles. Merchandise prizes for semifinalists. Division 2 of Open Doubles offers merchandise prizes for first, second and semifinalists. The merchandise prizes will be nice. No cheap crap will be awarded.
