ENTRY DEADLINE: All entries must be **RECEIVED BY June 7th, 2026**. Late entries may or may not be accepted with a \$10 late fee. ALL entry fees paid are **non-refundable** as of June 7th, 2026. All entries canceled before June 7th, 2026 are subject to a \$15 processing fee. No exceptions. **No** entry will be accepted without an entry form (online or mailed) and payment.

ELIGIBILITY: An Official USATT sanctioned tournament. Proof of USATT membership required for all events. Rating will be processed through USATT.

FORMAT: Singles events will start with preliminary round robin (RR) of 3 or 4 players followed by a single elimination (SE) main draw. One or two players will advance from the preliminary RR depending on the number of entrants. Format subject to change based on actual number of players.

EQUIPMENT: White Butterfly 3-Star Ball R40+ will be used. A total of 8 ITTF Approved Butterfly and YinHe tables will be used. ITTF approved blue rubber floor mat on all courts.

ENTRY FEE: Open Singles: \$50. Doubles: \$30/player, for all other events \$40 per event, Early Bird \$10 off per event sign up and paid by May 17th. Entries must be fully paid.

RULES:

- ❖ All USATT regulations, including equipment, conduct, dress, and language, apply.
- ❖ All matches are best of 5 games to 11 points except semifinals and final of the Open Singles, which are best of 7 to 11.
- ❖ It is recommended that players bring two legal rackets.
- ❖ Players must arrive at least 30 minutes before the event starting time.
- ❖ Ratings as of May 1st, 2026 on the USATT website will be used to establish eligibility. The most recent rating will be used for seeding. Estimated ratings for new players may be accepted from USATT certified coaches or the tournament director for seeding purpose. Un-rated players may or may not advance from the RR's in the rating events at tournament referee's discretion.
- ❖ Juniors for age event must be under 11 years old on 6/14/2026.
- ❖ All decisions made by tournament referee or director will be final.
- ❖ Prize(s) may be forfeited if the match is not played unless approved by the tournament director.
- ❖ Events may be canceled or combined if needed. In the event of cancellation, fees will be refunded.

ENTRY BLANK TEMPLATE FOR USATT SANCTIONED
TOURNAMENTS

I understand USATT's Safe Sport Policy including the organization's Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs

and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have **regular contact with or authority over** minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website:

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
