ELIGIBILITY: Must be a current member of the USATT or other ITTF affiliated association. USATT membership can be purchased with your tournament entry. We will use the latest USATT rating system to conduct all draws. Unrated players can play in and advance in under 1000 RR events. The tournament director reserves the right not to let an unrated play advance in rated events at his sole discretion.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries can be entered online at www.omnipong.com or at the club facility. All entries must be received or postmarked by Sunday, October 13th. Late entries, phone entries and walk-ins will only be accepted if space is available and at the director's discretion. Players may enter multiple events. Events with insufficient entries may be canceled with entry fees fully refunded. Please check-in 30 minutes prior to your event start time.

VENUE/EQUIPMENT: 6 ITTF-approved Butterfly tables with nets, Butterfly R40+ white plastic balls. ITTF-approved red sport flooring and LED lighting on all courts.

REGULATION: All USATT regulations apply and USATT approved equipment is to be used. Please refer to the USATT dress code guidelines for clothing/attire.

USATT MEMBERSHIP: Current USATT or other ITTF affiliate membership required of all participants. Basic Membership: \$25/year, Pro Membership: \$75/year.

DEFAULTS: Any player that defaults without communicating to the tournament director may be defaulted from the remaining events of the tournament.

EVENTS FORMAT: All single events will have a round robin stage followed by a single elimination draw. All matches are best of 5 games to 11 points. Events may be canceled or combined if there are insufficient entries. Fees will be refunded if canceled.

I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants at USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have regular contact with or authority over minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport.

PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, all persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** related to the operations of a USATT Sanctioned Tournament must be **fully Safe Sport Compliant**. Full Safe Sport Compliance means completing the SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport every twelve months and undergoing a criminal background screen every twenty-four months.

The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <https://www.usatt.org/athlete-resources/safesport>.

COACHING POLICY AT USATT SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS

Each and every **adult (person over the age of 18)** serving as a tournament coach and/or providing tournament in-match playing advice to a **minor athlete (person under the age of 18)** must be **fully Safe Sport Compliant**.

A parent and/or legal guardian is permitted to coach his or her own child without being Safe Sport Compliant.

An adult is permitted to provide tournament in-match playing advice to another adult participant without being Safe Sport Compliant.

A minor is permitted to provide tournament in-match playing advice to another minor athlete without being Safe Sport Compliant.

Persons serving as a tournament coach and/or providing tournament in-match playing advice to another participant are required to properly display a credential, indicating that such person has been vetted and approved by the Tournament Director to serve in this capacity.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, **ALL Adult Participants** (participants over the age of 18) **who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement**.
