Governance: All USATT Rules apply.

**Format**: All Matches are best 3 out of 5 games to 11pts. Two players advance (Any Singles) from round robin to single elimination for all single events. It will be either 4 or 5 players in each group usually. Two teams from each group advance to semifinals for the Doubles events.

Check-in: 20 min. prior to start time.

**Equipment: 3-Star Nittaku 40+ white balls** made in Japan Plastic balls will be used on 4 Butterfly Octet25 tables on hardwood flooring.

Ratings: USATT website ratings as of February 15, 2026. Unrated players must be approved by the tournament committee and assigned a rating to play in any rated event. **NO WHITE SHIRTS ALLOWED.** 

**Proof of Membership:** Must show the proof of USATT membership at the events. Basic yearly membership is \$25 and Pro Yearly membership \$75.

**Entry deadline:** All mail/email/online registrations must be received by Feb 15, 2026. No refunds after Feb 18, 2026 unless the event is canceled.

#### PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: <a href="https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport">https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport</a>.

#### USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be Fully Safe Sport Compliant, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

#### ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

#### CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at <a href="mailto:Admin@usatt.org">Admin@usatt.org</a> for more information and guidance in this process.

#### MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.** To learn more about the appropriate agency where you can submit a report of child abuse, log onto: <a href="https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting">https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting</a>.

and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children must be fully Safe Sport Compliant, which includes completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Cente
for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.
I understand that, pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, all participants a USATT Sanctioned Tournaments who are over the age of 18 and have <u>regular contact with o authority over</u> minor athletes must complete annual SafeSport Training offered by the US Center fo SafeSport.
